Information Collection & Use

This site does not use cookies. ([Definition of Cookies](#)).

Any information we collect is:

- used to improve the content of our Web Site.
- used to notify visitors of updates to the Web Site
- never sold to other organisations

Registration is not required to enter our Web Site except in order to make a booking.

During an on-line booking session, personal details must be entered. This data falls into two categories:

- Contact Details (Name, Address, Phone, email etc) are used during credit authorisation and if we need to contact you.
- Financial Details (Credit Card Number, expiry date etc) are used to process your payment.

Collection of all information is undertaken using SSL encryption and passed to the bank for authorisation. Access to the client section of our website is protected by secure password. Passwords are not stored in our systems in any form that can be accessed by a third party nor known by any member of staff at The Town House. You are responsible for the security of your password and it should not be written down or passed on to any third party.
